Reinstating the Project U-turn Program

The Liberals understand the critical importance of rehabilitative and restorative justice programs to prevent crime in Tasmania.

As part of our Plan for a Brighter Future, a majority Liberal government will provide a total of \$2 million over four years to re-instate the highly successful U-turn program for youth at risk.

U-turn is a restorative justice program that has been operating for 10 years, designed for young people aged 15-20 who have been involved in, or at risk of being involved in, motor vehicle theft or offences.

The Green-Labor Government has set this important youth justice program adrift, with funding to run out this year.

We will provide the lifeline they need.

The Liberals recognise the value of diverting young people from the criminal justice system into education and learning opportunities and employment to get their lives back on track.

The community and economy also benefit, because U-turn cuts youth crime, reduces reoffending and gets kids back into education and jobs.

Further, the cars restored by U-turn participants are donated back to victims of crime or programs, like community driver training.
